

Escape to the simple, rugged beauty of Tassie to play its world-leading golf courses, sample its honest and uncomplicated dining, and discover a complex and rich history that still remains evident in every-day life. The Apple Isle is a world away, and yet still so close to home. Its fresh, crisp mornings and evenings also makes for truly enjoyable golfing.

Two PGA Professional including Kieran Moran and a colleague will guide this tour and provide guests with in-game coaching and PGA Clinics.

### 6-8 March 2021

Our golfing escape starts when we fly into Launceston and head to lake-side resort Country Club Tasmania, where we will spend our first two nights; we'll play its championship golf course, which is widely considered Tassie's finest original links, and hold our welcome dinner at the highly-regarded Kitchen Terrace. We can also visit its on-site casino! On day three, we'll play the Riverside Golf Course and then head to the magnificent Barnbougle Golf Links and Resort.

### 8-12 March 2021

We will spend our next four nights at the incredible Barnbougle Golf Links Resort, located on the rugged northern coastline. We will play its internationally-acclaimed golf courses The Dunes and Lost Farm and enjoy its famous hospitality. We will dine each night at a different Barnbougle restaurant, culminating on our final night with our three-course tour championship dinner at the Lost Farm Restaurant.



## Flights

---

### **The flights we are looking to take are with Jetstar:**

- Sydney to Launceston on 6 March 2021, JQ745, departing Sydney 720am, and
- Launceston to Sydney on 12 March 2021, JQ746, departing 935am

The cost for flights is about \$270 at present. This may vary slightly based on availability and time of booking. Please note, we will confirm this flight once the tour numbers are finalised. Please wait until we confirm the tour with each guest before investigating flights (if you plan to book individually).

## Travelling with golf clubs, and hire equipment

---

### **Travelling with clubs on flights**

We require that you travel with your golf clubs on this trip. We will need to be mindful of weight restrictions for our flights from Sydney to Launceston return; and if you book our group flight with us, I will advise the weight limits. Otherwise, please check your weight limits with your airline.

### **Cart hire and equipment**

We will contact you to confirm your hire equipment needs, such as electric carts or pull buggies for each golf course, after booking.

## COVID-19 Safety

---

### **This tour will follow these COVID-Safe Guidelines:**

- Small tour groups of 16 to 20 (including two PGA): enforced social distancing where possible
- Screened tour partners for COVID-safety: hotels and golf must have COVID-safe policies
- Dining: dinner tables of up to 12-15 or private rooms, lunch packs at golf and breakfast at each guest's discretion
- Golf and clinics: enforced GolfNSW COVID-Safe guidelines
- Travel: limited group transport by coach and planes, this tour is based at Launceston and then Barnbougle only
- Tour hygiene: hand sanitiser regularly provided
- Payments for beverages: each guest must pay for their own drinks at all times
- Screening guests and tour guides: guests screened for travel to COVID-hotspots or symptoms of the virus and not allowed to travel with us. Guest's temperatures taken each morning.

**Upon landing, our coach will take us to Country Club Tasmania to check in.**

Country Club Tasmania is a lake-side resort with an on-site casino, located in the beautiful Tamar Valley wine-making region. It includes a range of activities, from golf to tennis and horse-riding, and hosts a variety of niche and large-scale events each year.

**At 3pm, we'll meet in the hotel lobby and walk to the practise area for our tour warm up clinic.**

**Afterwards, please enjoy free time and then at 645pm meet us at the hotel lobby to head to Kitchen Terrace, on-site, for our three-course welcome dinner.**


**Please meet in the lobby at 915am to walk to Lost Farm Golf Course for our PGA clinic, and afterwards to tee-off for our round of golf.**





## Disclaimers and important information

---

### Deposits and cancellations

We will invoice a holding deposit of \$250 per person, and then the balance in January 2021, The holding deposit is refundable if we are prevented from travelling to Tasmania due to coronavirus. If, in January after you have paid your full tour fee, our tour is prevented from travelling to Tasmania due to coronavirus, your tour fee will become a credit for the tour at a later, rescheduled date (ie. your tour fee is non-refundable from January 2021). All figures are in Australian dollars. If after January and payment of your tour fee, you live in an area that is deemed to be a coronavirus hotspot, or you contract coronavirus, and this prevents you from travelling with us, and we will place your tour fee into credit for use at a later time (it will not be refunded).

### Other cancellations (not related to coronavirus)

Cancellations by the client must be in writing to Moran Golf Tours. We understand that life events can impact on a guest's ability to travel on our tour once they have paid and we commit to assisting guests to back-fill their position on the tour should they be unable to attend. However, where we are unable to do so, the tour guest is liable for the tour cost in full and we will not provide any refund.

### Unexpected changes

Accommodation, dining and golf is subject to changes out of our control. We will endeavour to keep as close to the above itinerary as possible and all hotels/golf courses/restaurants will be replaced by those of a similar calibre.

All certificates and other travel documents for services issued by Moran Golf Tours are subject to the terms and conditions specified by the supplier and to the laws of the countries in which the services are supplied.

### Damage

Moran Golf Tours takes no responsibility for any damage caused by tour guests when travelling, such as damage to their property or that of a third party. We also take no responsibility for any guest's items that are lost or damaged during transit or on tour. This is why we recommend taking out an insurance policy and ensuring it provides adequate protection for such instances.

### **Medical conditions**

It is important we are aware of our guest's medical conditions if they might in some way, affect them on one of our tours, so we can assist if necessary.

### **Travel Insurance**

Please ensure you have adequate insurance to cover you for any medical needs or emergencies, damage or loss of property or any other unforeseen circumstances. This is at the cost of the tour guest.

Tour guests should also ensure their travel insurance policy provides adequate protection for any injury and/or medical expenses caused while on tour.

### **Delays and disruptions**

While delays, disruptions and cancellations are an unfortunate part of travel, if we are delayed or our itinerary is changed we will do our best to ensure we can provide an equivalent service in so much as is possible. When you confirm your spot on our tour with your payment, you acknowledge these terms.

### **Flights**

Flights are not included in the tour price and researching, booking and confirming flights is at the tour guest's discretion (unless otherwise stated). At times, Moran Golf Tours can assist our guests with their flights by connecting them to a travel agent, however Moran Golf Tours takes no responsibility for flights or any associated activity.

### **Baggage allowances**

Moran Golf Tours can provide our guests with information on travel baggage allowances as we understand it, however each tour guest must make their own enquiries and confirmations regarding travel baggage allowances and any other restrictions or allowances as pertaining to flights.
