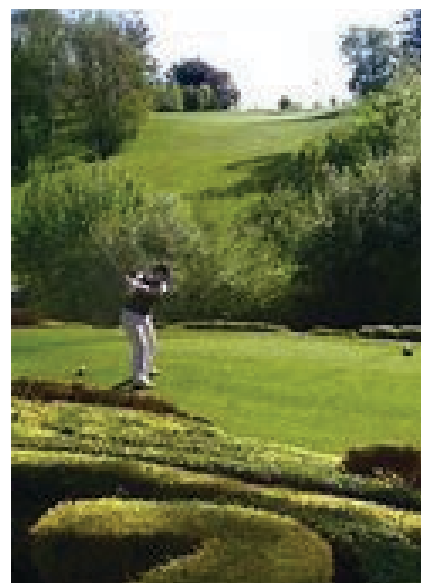
We will hold our first PGA clinic, and then tee-off for four round.

The European Club is a privately-owned links course, located in tumbling dunes just south of Dublin and features sweeping sea views from nineteen of the twenty holes. There are two extra par-3s here and they are in play most days affording the golfer a 20-hole round which includes five holes running very close to the sea. So close that it is common to find players searching for their golf balls on the beach.

This course is one of the longest links at 7,377-yards from the tips.

Please enjoy a drink in the clubhouse and enjoy free time as your round finishes. After golf, we'll head back to the hotel.

The mystical Druids Glen is well known for its manicured tree-lined fairways, historical landmarks, spectacular water features and vibrant floral displays.

This famous course designed by Pat Ruddy and Tom Craddock, opened in 1995. Just a year after opening, Druids Glen hosted the Irish Open for four years in a row. Colin Montgomerie won two years running, followed by David Carter and Sergio Garcia, shooting a 64 in the final round.

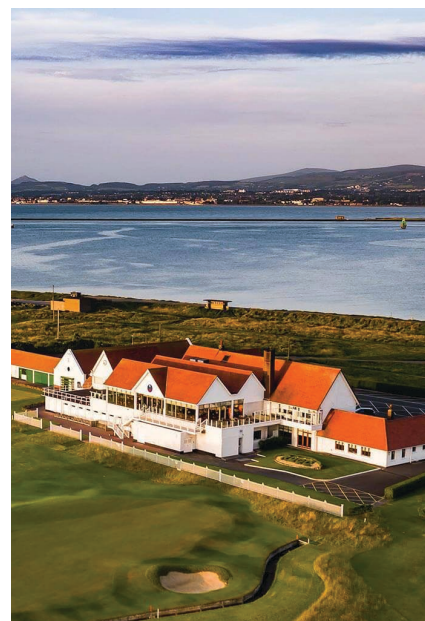
We'll start with a warm up PGA clinic and then tee-off for our round.

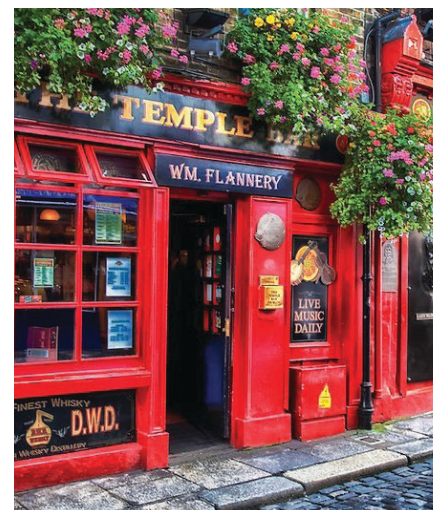

This course will deliver thrills and excitement; course designer Harrison Minchew created this 'sculptured brute', featuring moulding, clever bunkering, amazing water hazards and huge sloping greens.

We will meet at the hotel lobby at 6:45pm to walk to the Palmer Restaurant at the hotel for dinner.

The focus at The Palmer is on modern comfort food, from classic dishes to flatbreads, sharing plates, fresh salads and fish, great food from the grill and lots of generous and delicious sides. The Palmer takes a sunny and satisfying approach to produce-led dishes in a luxurious but informal atmosphere.

Offering 18 of the most exciting and dramatic holes in Europe, The Palmer North course promises to entice and challenge even the most avid of golfers. At every turn, fairway, cascading water feature or leafy, verdant space, a challenge ensues.

The 7,350 yards this course is set around the River Liffey which flows through the 550 acre lush Kildare estate. Mature indigenous Irish trees allowing the golfer to test their game in all aspects.

The walk through the course is a true joy, a myriad of landmarks can be spotted throughout, including a quaint 19th Century iron bridge at the 16th and the ruins of an ancient church can be spotted as you approach the 13th. The island 16th, moon shaped 17th and dog leg 18th, provide an incredible finish to a spectacular course.
