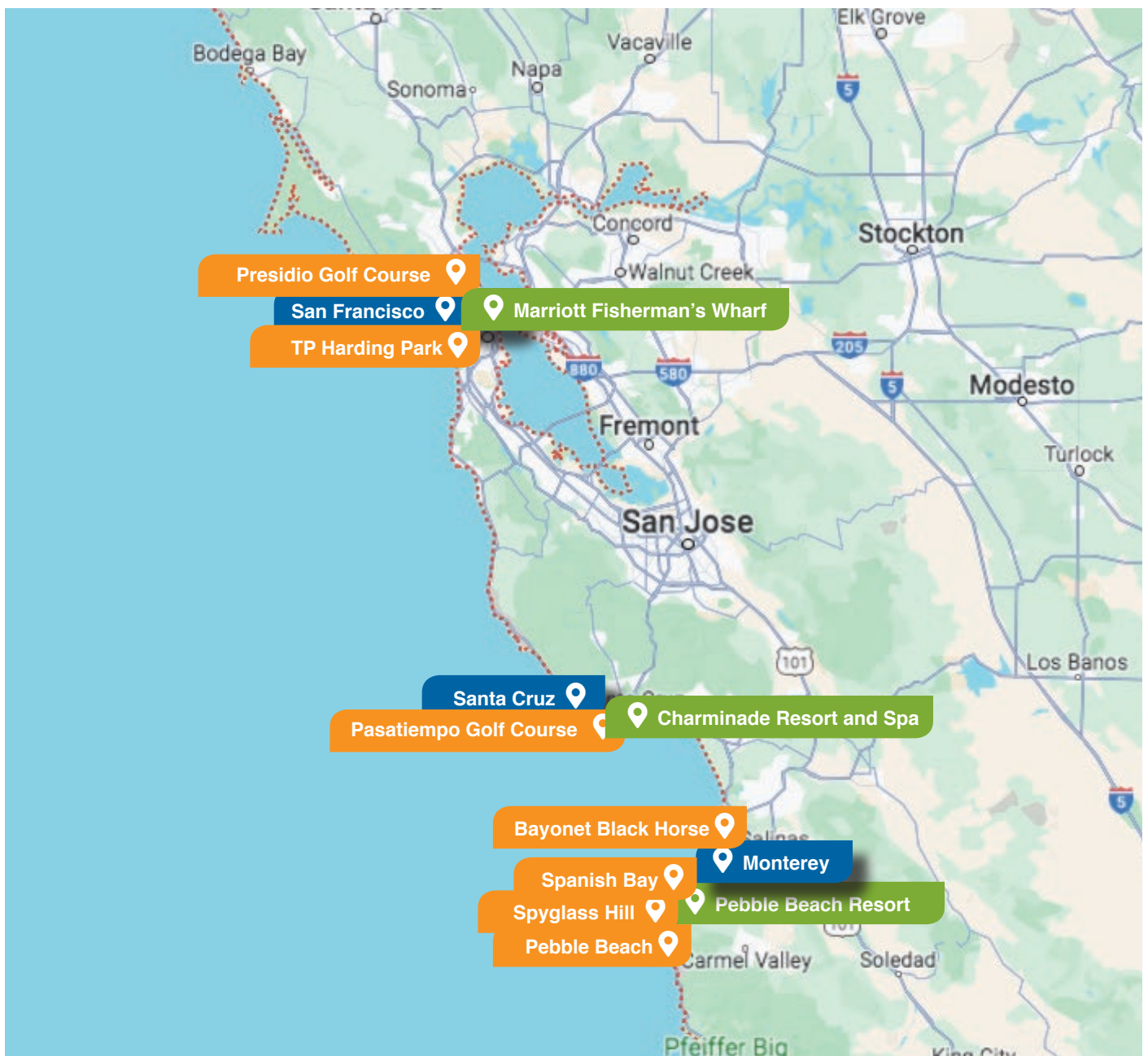

Formerly known as Harding Park Golf Club, this course is owned by the city and county of San Francisco. Named after avid golfer and former President Warren G. Harding, the golf course was designed by Willie Watson (who also designed the Olympic Club). It is a 27 hole championship course and hosted the PGA Championship in 2020. TPC Harding Park was rated no.13 Municipal Golf Course in the US and the no. 24 Best Course to Play in California by Golfweek Magazine.

Following our clinic, our first group will tee-off.

Please enjoy a drink in the clubhouse as our group finishes, and we'll award our winners for today.

After golf, we'll head back to the hotel.


At 6:20pm we'll meet at the hotel lobby to walk to dinner at Wipe Out Grill.


Wipe Out Bar and Grill was created to be the best surf food and beach shack in San Francisco. Their classic beach restaurant is wildly-popular with locals.

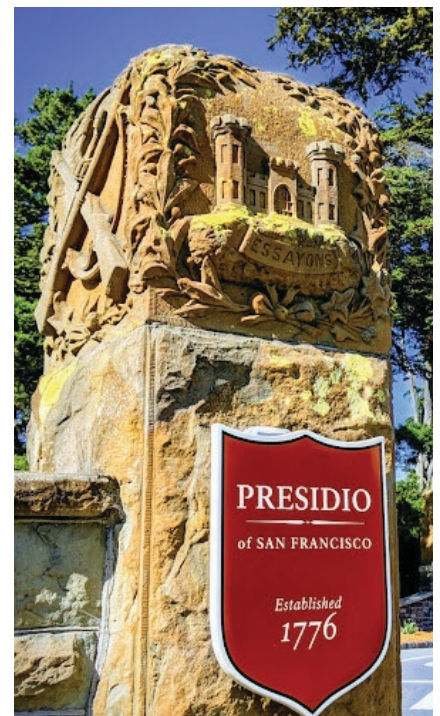
Please meet us in the lobby at 9:30am and we will drive to Presidio Golf Course ahead of our tee-times.

Set on 300 mountaintop acres, this polished, mission-style resort is 5 kms to downtown Santa Cruz, and 6.5 kms to Santa Cruz Beach Boardwalk.

Please meet us at in the hotel lobby at 7pm to head for dinner at The View Restaurant, on-site.

Enjoy gorgeous expanded panoramic ocean views at The View Restaurant. Its menu is inspired by the local surroundings of the Central Californian Coast known as the 'salad bowl'. This region is blessed with enriched produced, fresh fish and amazing meats. The View's chef honors the fresh, flavorful, local favorites and creates artisan dishes that reflects this amazing region.
